

**NEPTUNE FIRE DISTRICT #1
CAPITAL APPROPRIATIONS QUESTION
NOVEMBER 4, 2021**

Public Question

“SHALL THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS, TOWNSHIP OF NEPTUNE, FIRE DISTRICT NO.1, BE AUTHORIZED TO APPROPRIATE FROM ITS RESTRICTED FUND BALANCE \$1,075,000.00 OF ITS RESTRICTED FUND BALANCE TO USE AS GENERAL REVENUE IN THE DISTRICT’S 2022 FIRE DISTRICT BUDGET?”

A "yes" vote will authorize the Board of Commissioners of Neptune Fire District #1 to use \$1,075,000.00 as general revenue in the district’s 2022 budget and appropriate said funds to provide and maintain essential district services for the residents of the district. Because the funds were previously restricted for capital purposes, this amount can be included in the budget when approved by referendum of the voters. This additional amount will be appropriated for the purposes set forth below, increasing the total appropriation for each such purpose from what would otherwise be appropriated:

**\$950,000.00 for the purchase of a new Fire Engine
\$125,000.00 for the purpose of Building upgrades to the Liberty Firehouse.**

A "no" vote means that the District Board of Commissioners budget will be adopted without the release of \$1,075,000.00 of its Restricted Fund Balance for use as general revenue.
